- A) Wye Heritage Marine Resort understands and recognizes the vital importance of maintaining a clean, natural environment as being fundamental to its activities.
- B) In accepting and adopting those best management principals and operating practices that are appropriate to its operation, Wye Heritage Marine Resort commits itself to the best of its ability to:
 - 1. Eliminate the release of contaminants into the water column, both directly and indirectly.
 - 2. Minimize the release of pollutants to the atmosphere.
 - 3. Avoid contaminations of the ground.
 - 4. Adopt waste reduction, reuse and recycling strategies.
 - 5. Optimize energy and water conservation.
 - 6. Promote good environmental practices to all parties.
 - 7. Abide by and where possible exceed the requirements of all relevant legislation.
- C) Wye Heritage Marine Resort management will introduce sound environmental practices into every aspect of our operation; we will train our employees to understand and implement these practices; we will provide the resources that are needed to allow the policy to be fulfilled.
- D) The philosophy of this policy will be integrated into the contract between Wye Heritage Marine Resort and our customers.
- E) All suppliers and subcontractors will be aware of the intent of this policy and will be encouraged to adopt the same good practices where appropriate.
- F) Wye Heritage Marine Resort also commits itself to an ongoing program of self-evaluation. We will strive to continually upgrade and improve our environmental performance in light of future developments in Marina management techniques and product availability.

To separate hazardous wastes, including used oils, and antifreeze, unwanted them in accordance with Marina guidelines or take all such wastes to the m	•	
4. To take all necessary steps to avoid spilling fuel, oil, or any chemicals or de	eaners whatsoever into the water to refrain fr	om numping oil contaminated bilge water over-

6. To use the land-based washroom facilities whenever practical, as long as the boat is at the dock and to avoid pumping grey water overboard when in the marina.

5. To carry out any repair work on the boat in designated areas only, taking all precautions required by the Marina to avoid leaving debris, litter, or liquid contaminants on

- 7. To never discharge raw sewage from black water holding tanks to anywhere other than an approved pump-out facility.
- 8. To use environmentally friendly products whenever and wherever possible.

board, and to be guided by instructions from the attendant when at the Fuel Dock.

- 9. To operate vessels in a safe and considerate manner at all times, to operate engines only when necessary, to avoid creating a wake when entering and leaving the dock, and to avoid causing a nuisance to all others using the marina facilities.
- 10. To always show respect for the environment and for fish, birds, and other animals, both aquatic and terrestrial, that share it with us.
- 11. To promote Clean Marine practices at all times.
